Demolition Works – Dunkirk Jetty

Mariners are advised that Demolition Works will be taking place at the Dunkirk Jetty in the Western Docks during the following times: -

Monday to Friday: 07:30 hrs to 18:30 hrs

Saturdays: 07:30 hrs to 14:30 hrs

Sundays and Public Holidays: No Works

Note: There is a requirement to carry out 24 hours wire cutting

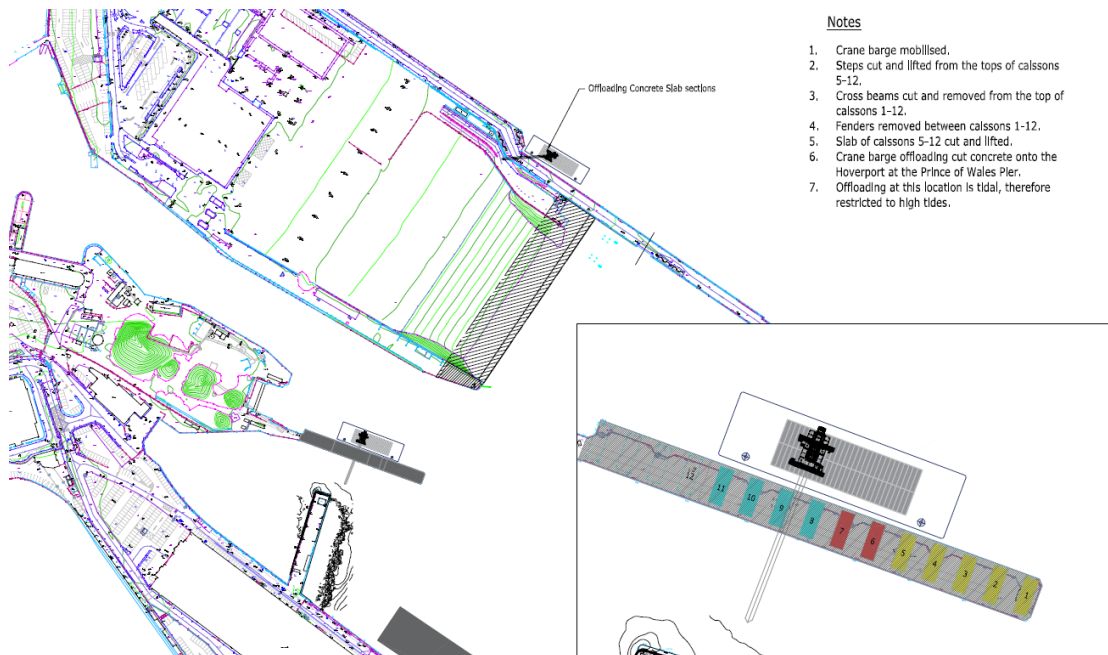
Works will commence on the 3rd April 2017 and continue until further notice, these works will be undertaken by the following vessels:

Multi Cat – Afon Goch

Multi Cat – Llandwyn Island

Dumb Barge – Willcarry 1500

Enak – 600T Shear Leg



The demolition works will involve wire cutting and heavy lifts. Vessels navigating within the area of these works, and via the Wick Channel should keep well clear of the Dunkirk Jetty and associated works vessels at all times. Vessels should in addition take directions from Dover Port Control on VHF Ch.74.

Safety vessel "CRC Hercules" will be in attendance throughout the works.
