Local Notice to Mariners 34/17

Heavy Lift Operations being carried out by sheerleg crane barge Enak

Mariners are advised that the heavy lift crane barge "Enak" will be operating in the vicinity of the Dunkerque jetty for the next four weeks. Mariners are advised to pass with minimum wash.

There may be short periods (1 to 2 hours) where the barge may be required to operate in the Wick Channel and access may be severely restricted during this time.

Information on the exact timings for restricted access in the Wick Channel will be promulgated using the Local Notice to Mainers distribution list.

Vessels are requested to pass clear and at a slow speed taking directions from Dover Port Control on VHF 74.
