



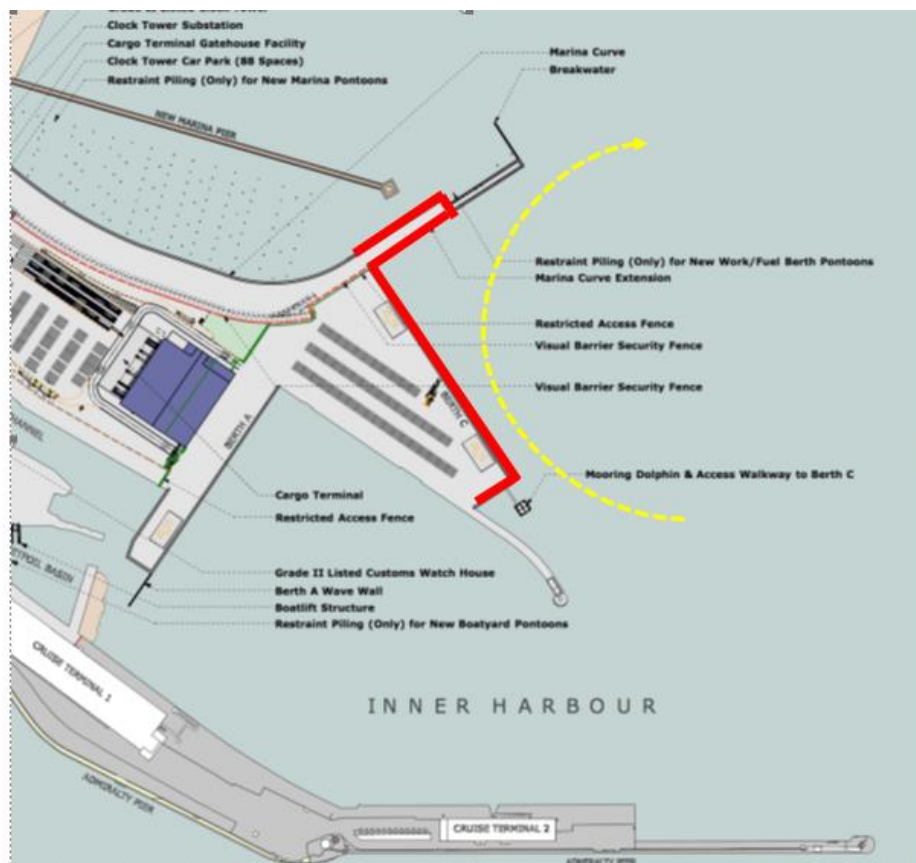
## PORT OPERATIONS

### Local Notice to Mariners 54/17

#### Tidal Flow Outer Harbour

Mariners are advised that piling works and associated infill sheet piles for the DWDR berth C and the initial new Marina curve (highlighted in red in the diagram below) are nearing completion and are expected to be finished by Friday 25<sup>th</sup> August 2017. On completion of these civil works, the face of berth C and the Marina curve become solid and thus may deflect and alter the usual clockwise tidal flow in the Outer Harbour, as indicated by the yellow tidal flow arrow in the diagram below.

Mariners are therefore advised to navigate with caution and in particular whilst manoeuvring off the heads of the Eastern Docks ferry berths during the Western Entrance Jet Stream period.
