Diving Operations Western Docks

Mariners are advised that diving operations will be carried out on both the west side of the Prince of Wales pier and within the Wick Channel as depicted in diagrams 1 and 2 below. Diving will take place from 07:00 to 19:00 from the 14/09/2017 to the 21/09/2017.

Throughout the operation the barge "Willcarry 1500" will act as the dive support vessel and a safety vessels will be in attendance.
